- Emerging Micro Enterprises (EME) and Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE) with a level 1 B-BBEE status contributor would be registered upon payment of a fee of R 200.00
- All other bigger businesses would be registered upon payment of a fee of R 500.00
- Stalls Registration Fees are not refundable and should be deposited to the FNB account no. 62363654156, Branch Code: 210920. Proof of deposits would be submitted for registration.
- Electricity would be available for the promotional stalls but own connection cables should be used when necessary but CHDA will not be held liable for any load-shedding occurrences
- No alcoholic beverages may be sold from the stalls.
